

MK Bike Show 2019

Terms and Conditions

Your attendance at the show is on condition that you agree to comply with the conditions below.

The MK Bike Show is being run for the third year, as a collaboration between Milton Keynes Advanced Motorcyclists, Buckinghamshire Fire and Rescue and Milton Keynes Council, with the generous support and assistance of Stadium:MK.

The show's chosen charities this year are Thames Valley Ambulance and the Institute of Advanced Motorcyclists - all monies raised after costs will be split between them.

The show will be open to the public from 10.00am and close at 4.00pm.

The areas will be opened for exhibitors to enter and set up from 8.00am. This will close at 9.45am. There will be no vehicular movements allowed on the outer concourse after 10.00am.

The main exhibition area is directly below the hotel rooms which are within the Stadium complex, ***please be considerate to residents whilst setting up, keeping noise to a minimum.***

From 08.00, please attend the exhibition site from the V6 Grafton Street entrance and head towards the MK1 Shopping car park. At the roundabout with Stadium Way West, the entrance to the outer concourse of the Stadium:MK is on your right. Please present yourself to a show steward adjacent to Gate 1 of the Stadium who will direct you to your allocated pitch. There will be a one way system employed during set up ***so please only approach from the above direction.*** For satnav, please use MK1 1ST and for a map go to -

Please be ready and set up by 10.00am.

All emergency exits to the stadium will be marked – ***please do not obstruct them***, as they are for the hotel residents' emergency exit during the show.

Please do not stick anything to the wall of the stadium or nail into the floor. Any gazebos must be secured by weights – be aware due to the location and design of the buildings, it can get windy around the stadium.

Please keep within your allocated area.

Quiet generators are permitted but please do not start them prior to 09:45 am. Stadium:MK allows us to use this area FOC and we wish to be considerate to the residents, so we are allowed back next year.

Ensure all electrics & cabling are safe (i.e. PAT tested) and not a trip hazard. Ensure the generator has sufficient fuel for the day as no refuelling is permitted on site. No running of engines is allowed during the day and if you allow visitors to climb on bikes, ensure these are secure and supervised at all times.

No naked flames or barbecues – plenty of options for food and drinks in the stadium and local outlets.

Please ensure you keep and leave your pitch clean and tidy. We will tidy the area prior to your arrival and when everyone has gone home.

All stands will be visited before opening, any questions, queries or suggestions please inform the steward. During the day there will be stewards passing by, any issues please inform them or go to the Milton Keynes Advanced Motorcyclists stand where they will contact a member of the event team.

We hope you find these conditions common sense and acceptable, we reiterate the fact that the show is being held for the benefit of those with an interest in all aspects of motorcycling, showcasing what is available to them from local trades and clubs/organisations. The event team are all volunteers giving their time freely and we look forward to your cooperation.
